The Grove City Community Library (GCCL) is a valuable and vital part of our community. Our GCCL is continuously serving, growing and thriving only because of support from people like you. We, the Friends of the GCCL, ask for your sustaining support in this annual fundraising campaign.

It may surprise, and hopefully encourage, you to know that the majority of our Library's annual budget of approximately \$250,000 is met by donations from our generous supporters. Grant money provides less than half, while State and Federal funding comprise the smallest portion. Even more amazing is all that your GCCL staff and volunteers accomplish with these funds.

The GCCL still serves as your "go to" place for books, both hard copy and electronic. Moreover, the Library offers a wide array of programming that is responsive to the needs of our community. One such program is the increasingly popular Summer Reading program; approximately 700 children participated last year. Other programs include: Resume Building, Employment Resources, Ancestry.com, Drop-In Tech Hour; crafts and themed events, such as A Night at Hogwarts; and, book clubs and reading groups for a variety of ages and interests. Most of these programs are free of charge, except for a materials fee for some.
