Cell Phone Use Policy

Many people visit the library expecting to find a quiet place to read or study. Although the Grove City Community Library does not encourage the use of cell phones in the building, we do understand that there are times when it may be necessary. During these times we ask that you be considerate and respectful of others by following the guidelines below:

1. When you enter the library, we ask that you turn the ringer on your cell phone to vibrate or off.
2. Be considerate of those around you, and keep your conversations short (less than 3 minutes) and your voice lowered when using your cell phone.
3. If you need to have an extended conversation, please exit the building to do so.
4. Do not use your phone at public service desks, public computer areas, study areas, or during library programs

Library patrons with cell phone usage that violates our behavior policy on disturbances, creating a disturbance by making noise, talking loudly or engaging in other disruptive conduct, will be asked to leave the building.
