Library Bits and Bytes



Are you trying to repair your vehicle and need part number information or wiring diagrams? The Auto Repair Reference Center, part of PA Power Library, offers information on most domestic & imported vehicles. It includes more than 31,660 vehicles, from 1945 to present, with over 205,000 drawings and step-by-step photographs, approximately 75,000 technical service bulletins & recalls, over 130,000 enhanced

wiring diagrams as well as specifications & maintenance schedules. The content in ARRC has been created by ASE certified technicians.

To access AARC, go to the library webpage at www.grovecitypalibrary.org and select the Resources tab. Scroll down until you see the AARC image then select it. Enter the PA Power Library code and your barcode then select Auto Repair Reference Center. If you need the Power Library code, contact the library.
