



Getting started with Libby

Libby is made possible by your local library and built with ♥ by OverDrive.

The Libby app is the easiest way to get started with digital titles from your public library!

Install the Libby app from the app store on your Android, iOS (iPhone/iPad/iPod touch), or Windows 10 device. Or, visit libbyapp.com in your Chrome, Firefox, Safari, or Edge browser.

In Libby, follow the prompts to find our library (Grove City's ZIP code is 16127, and we show up under the New Castle District Library Center) and sign in with a valid library card.

*Note: You must include the letter **P** with your library card number. If that doesn't work, you may need to add a space after the **P**.*

Browse our library's collection (it will say New Castle District Library Center) and borrow a title.

Borrowed titles appear under *Shelf > Loans* and download to the app automatically when you're on Wi-Fi, so you can read them when you're offline.

From your **Loans**, you can:

- Tap **Read With...** to choose whether you'd like to open a book in Kindle (U.S. libraries only) or Libby.

*Note: If you choose Kindle, you'll be taken to Amazon's website to finish getting the book. Sign into your Amazon account, verify the **Deliver To:** device, and tap **Get Library Book.**)*

- Tap **Open Audiobook** to start listening to an audiobook.
- Tap **Manage Loan** to see options like **Renew** and **Return**.
