




We have tried to picture for you the progress that has been made during these thirty years both in the curriculum and in the extra-curricular activities available to the students.





Members are elected from the junior and senior classes each year. At the monthly meetings topics of interest to the members are discussed. This group strives to be of service to the school and community.










Wrestling


