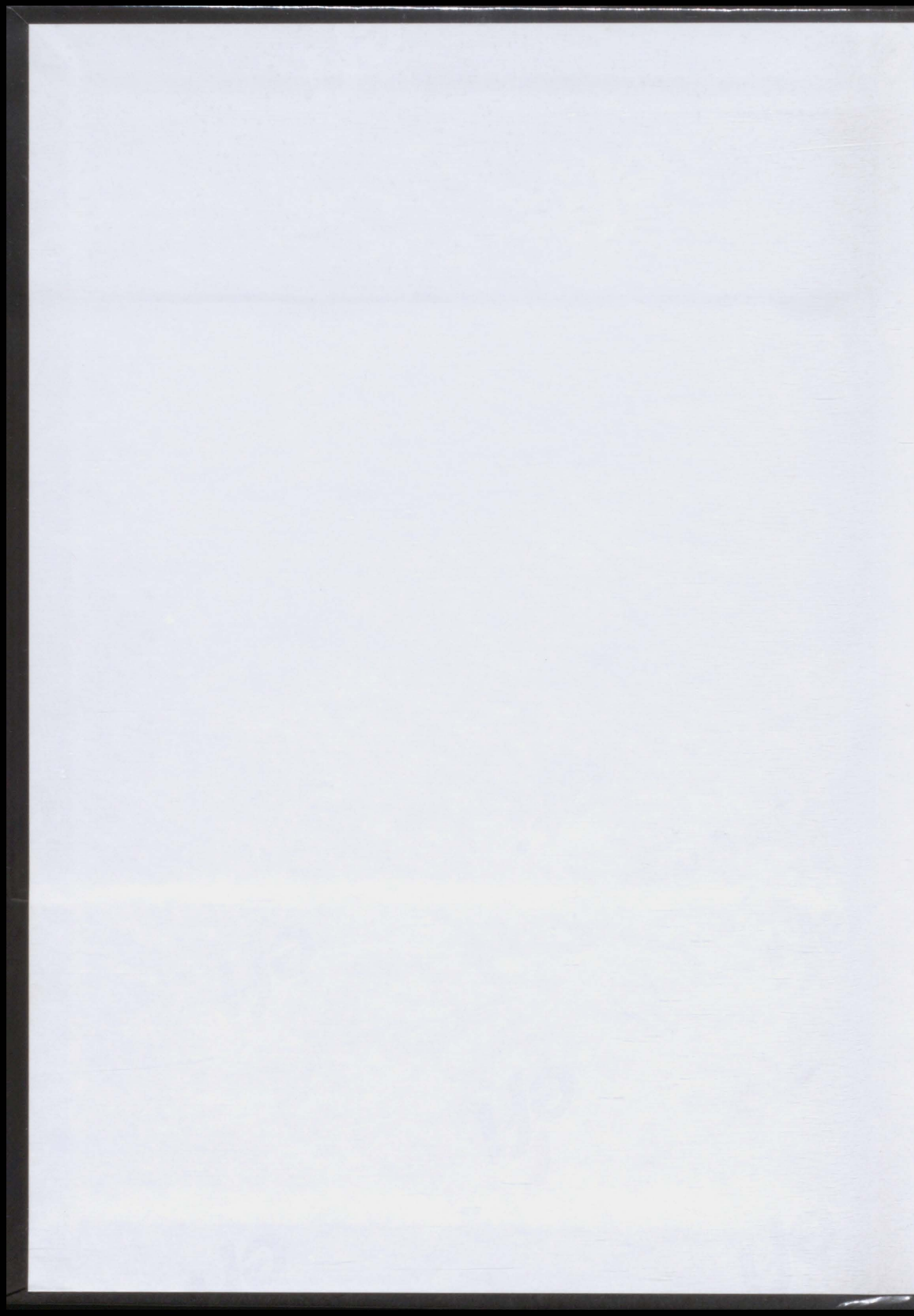


GROVE CITY AREA HIGH SCHOOL
