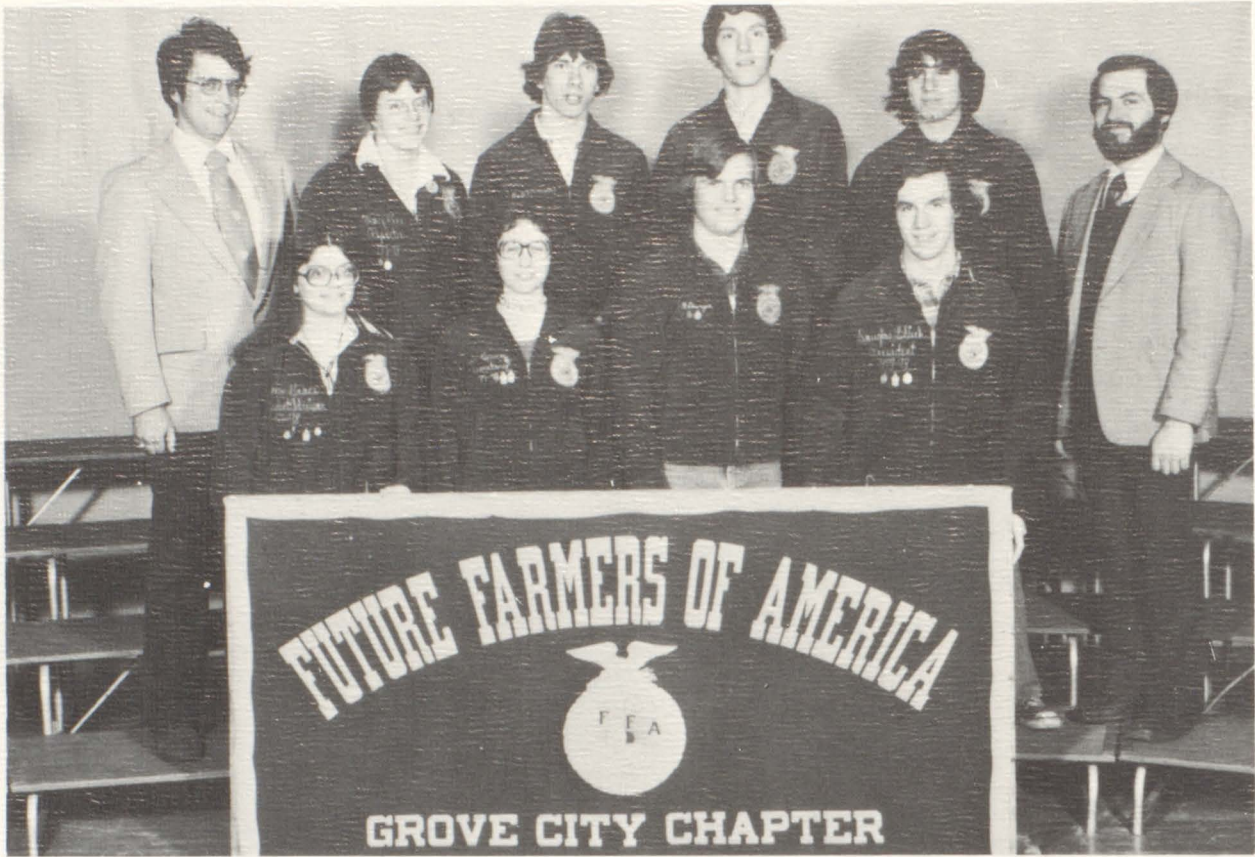

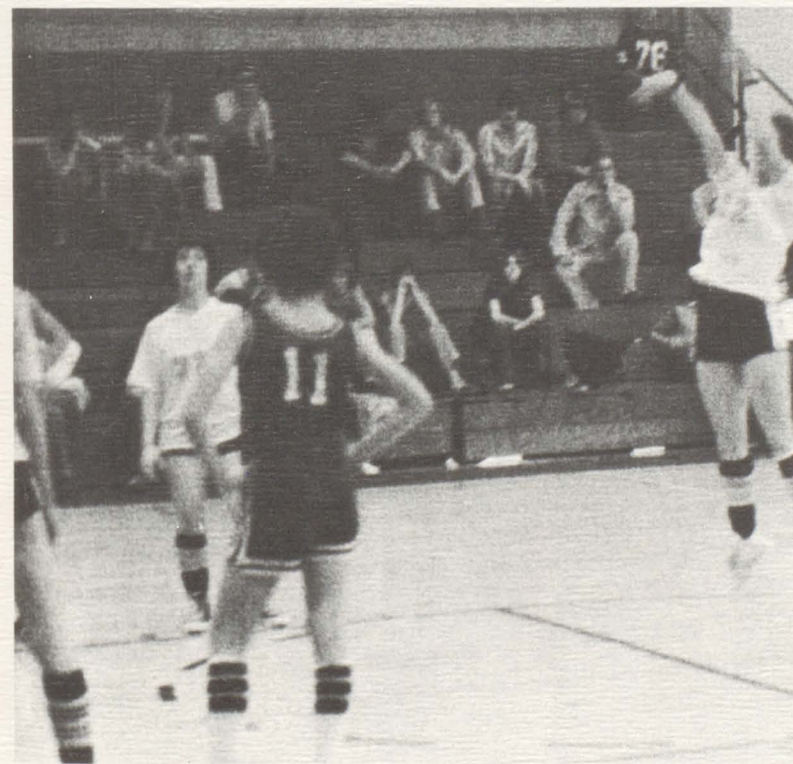

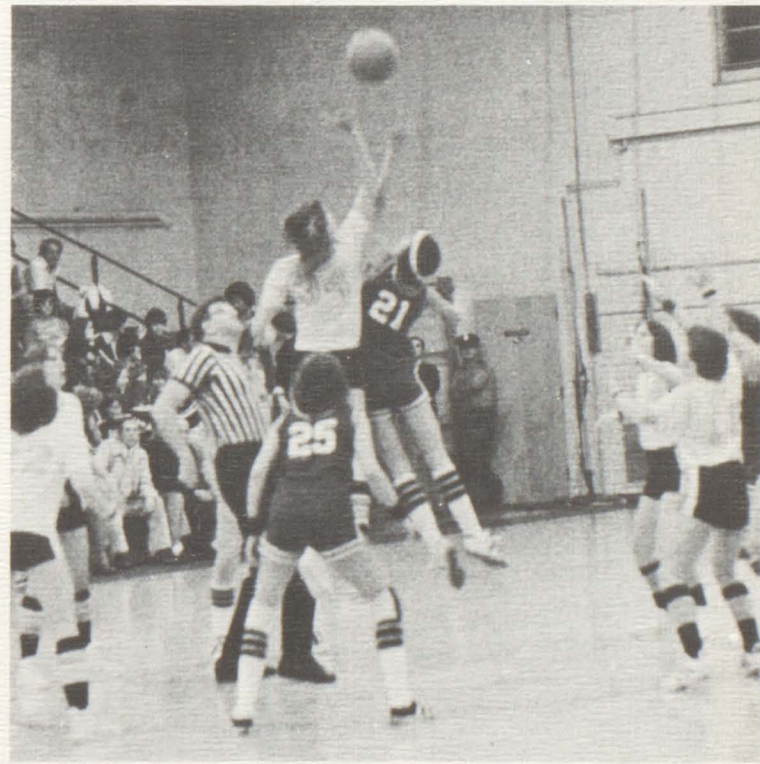

Assistant basketball coaches are Len Clarke, Roger Flynn, and Dick Adams. Athletic director is Joe Youngo.

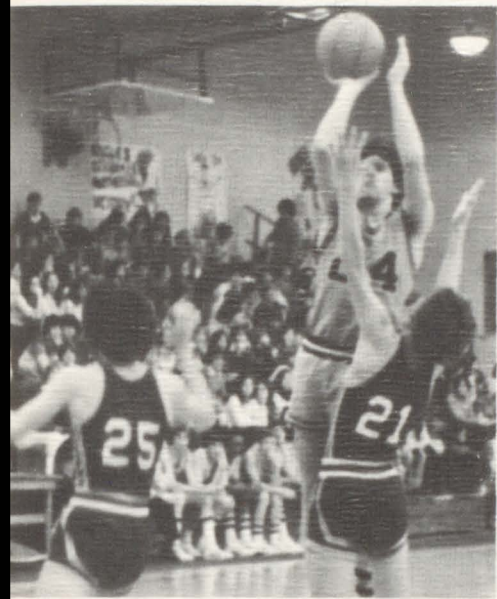

Eagles Improve Record — Have 5-5 Record

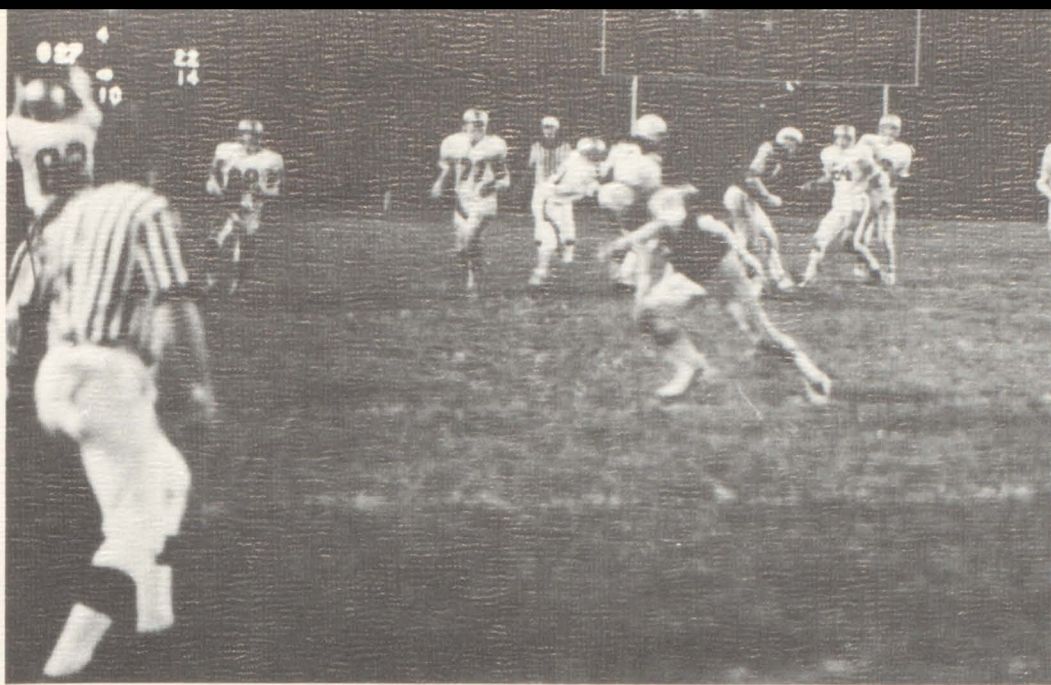

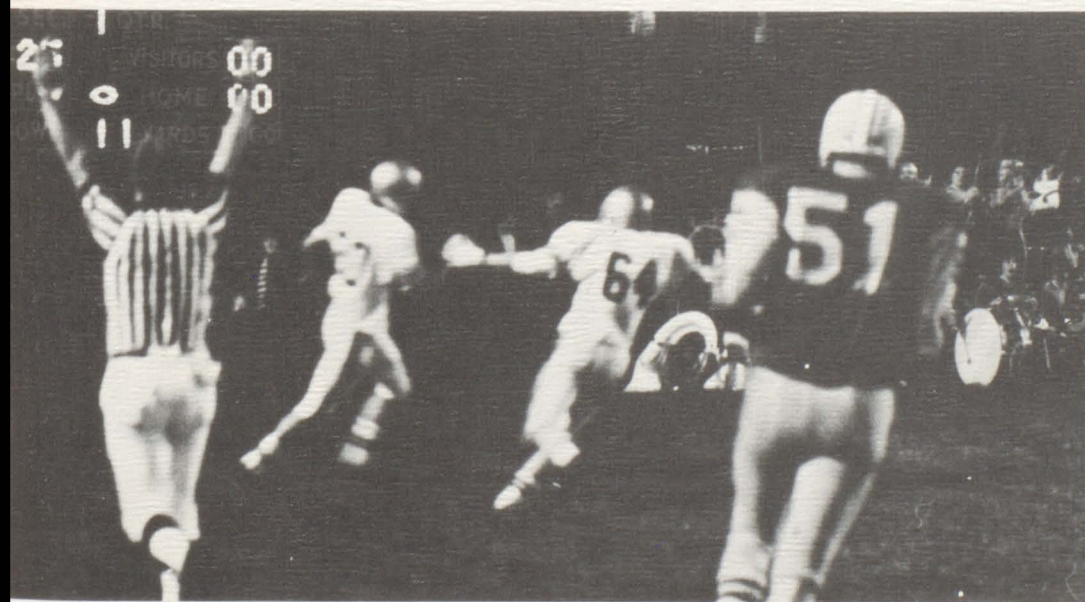
