

IN MEMORIAM



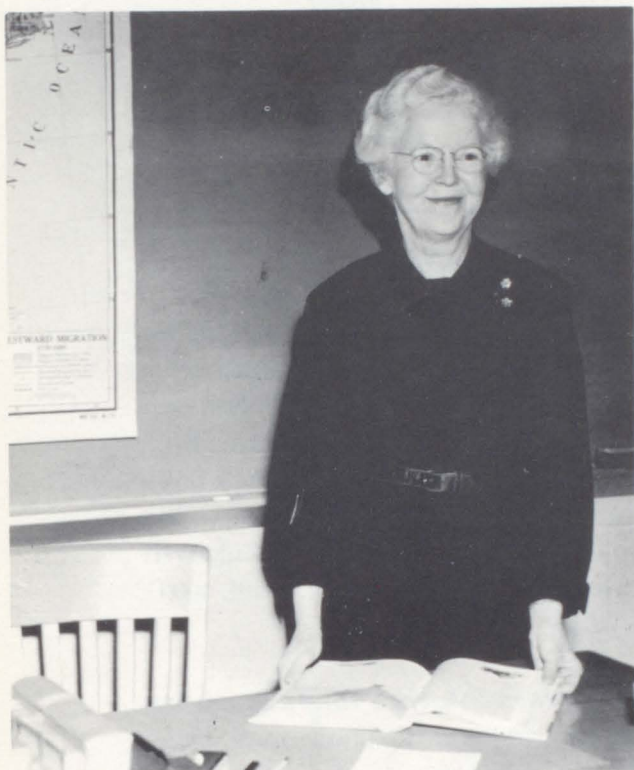
One of the most sorrowful moments in Grove City High School was felt by the students when news reached us of the death of our Principal, Mr. Harland J. Surrena.

We are presenting you with the largest year book that this school has ever produced. It is our desire that in future years this book may bring forth many happy memories.

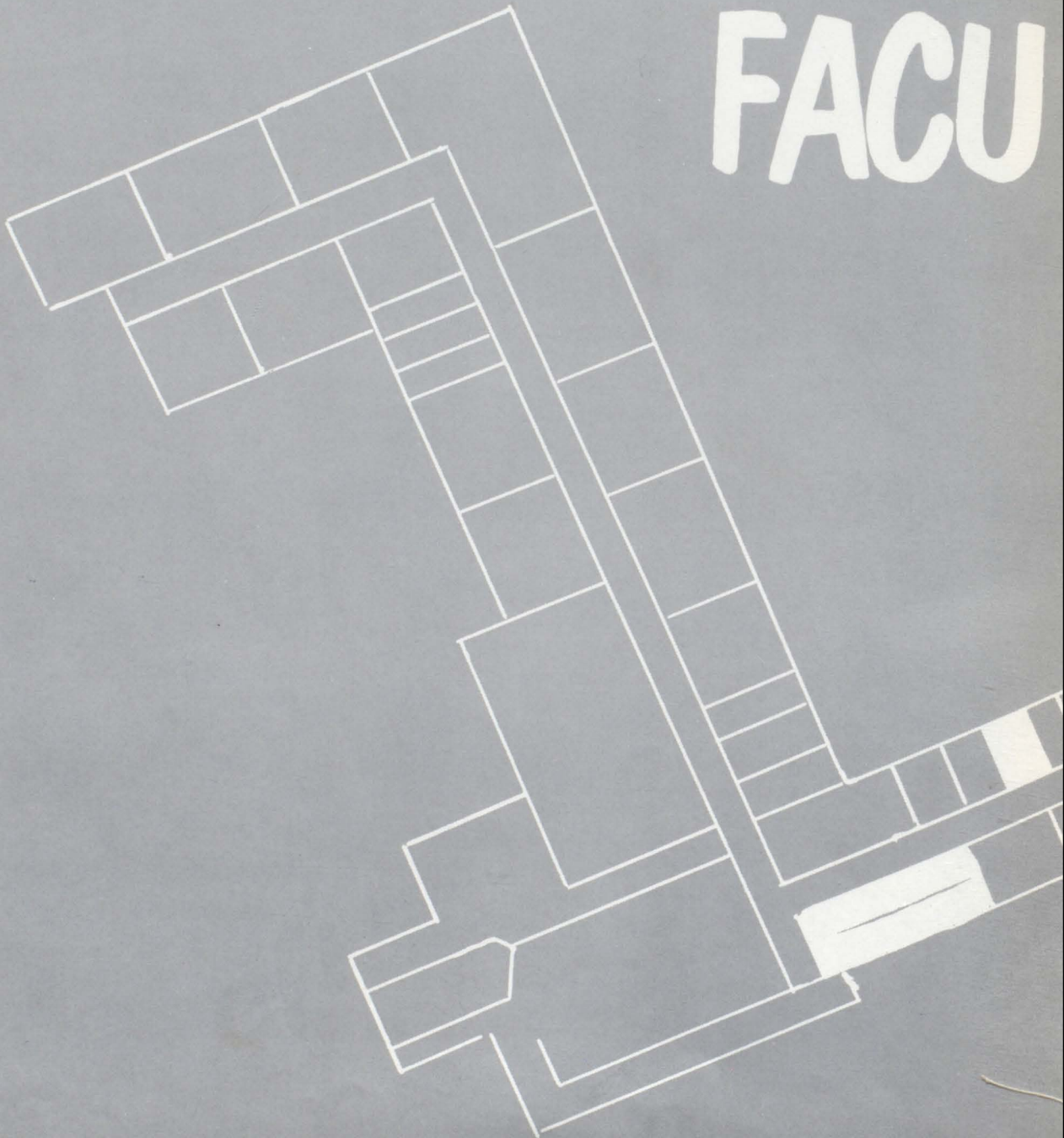

Even though we didn't make too good a showing in Varsity this year, we are all looking forward to a better season next year.

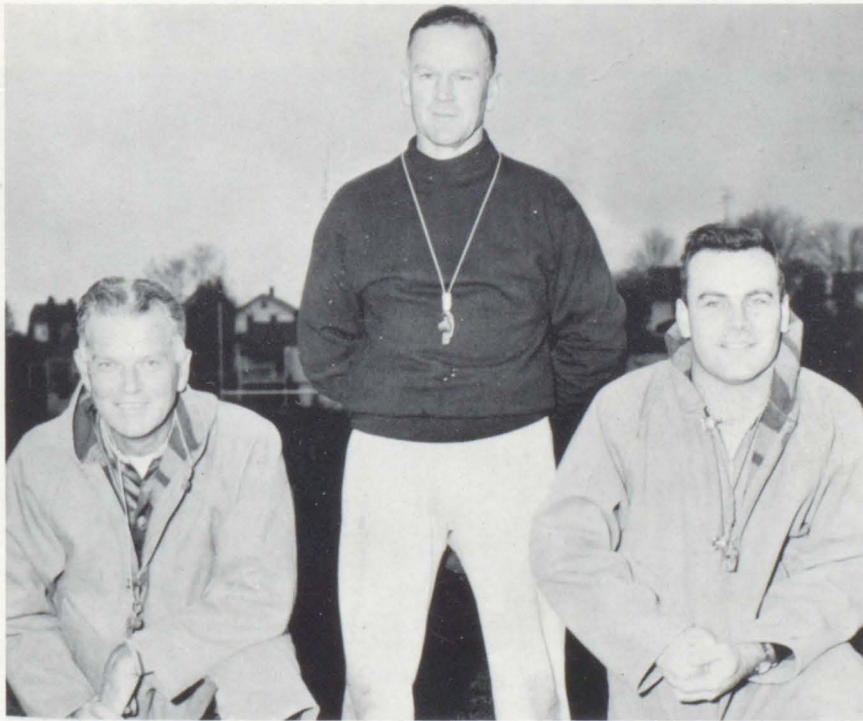
