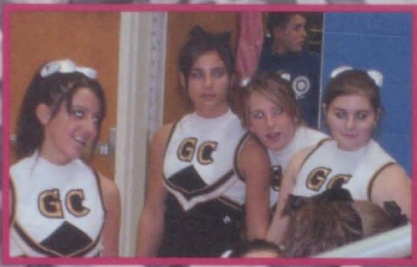




Wrestling Overview
