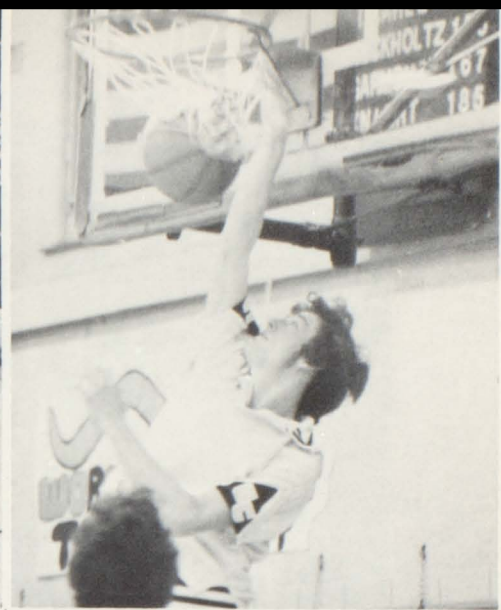
## Mercer County Champs

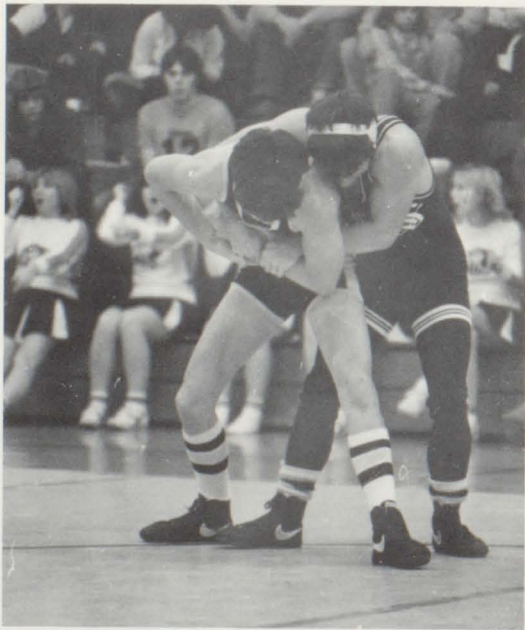
## Tennis

Selected students attend Vo-Tech one half of each school day for specialized vocational education, while academic subjects are taught at the high school the other half day.

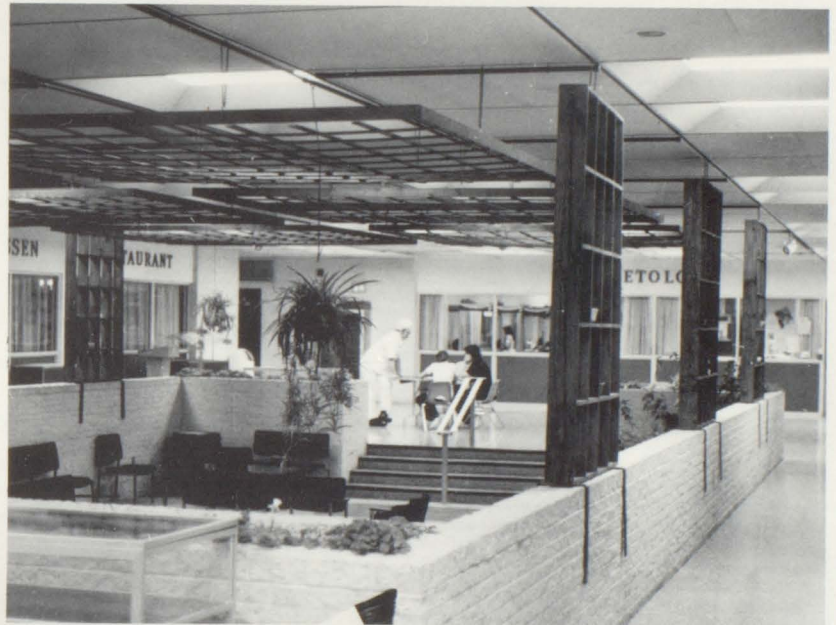

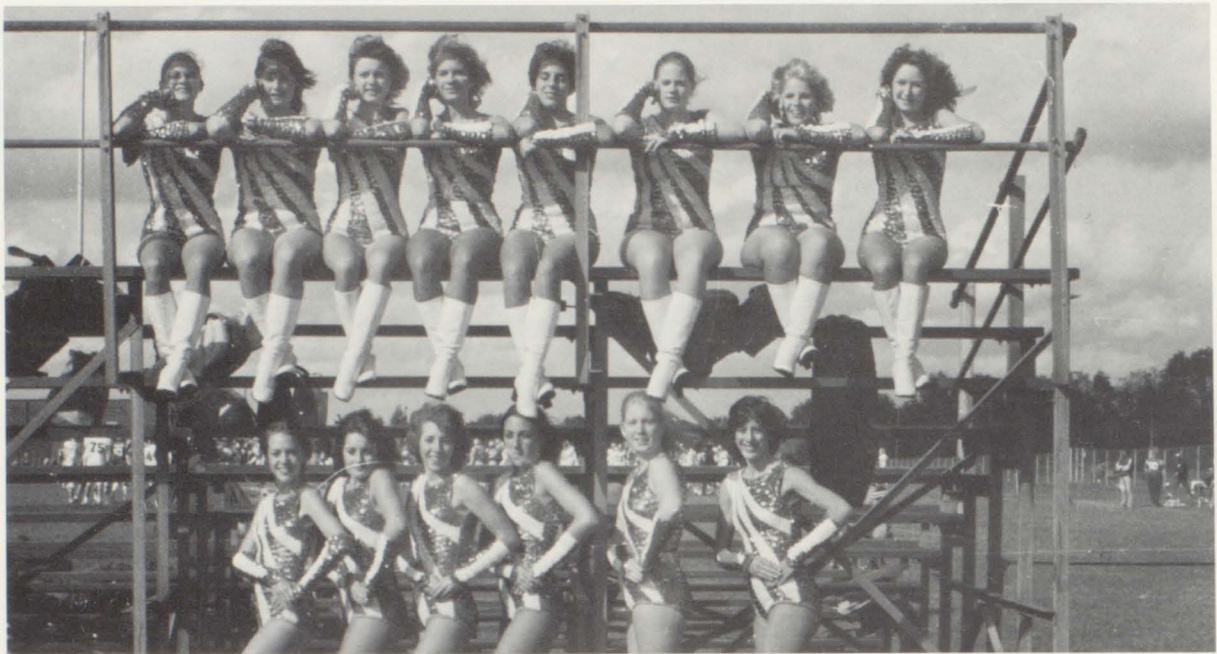
