MATHEMATICS

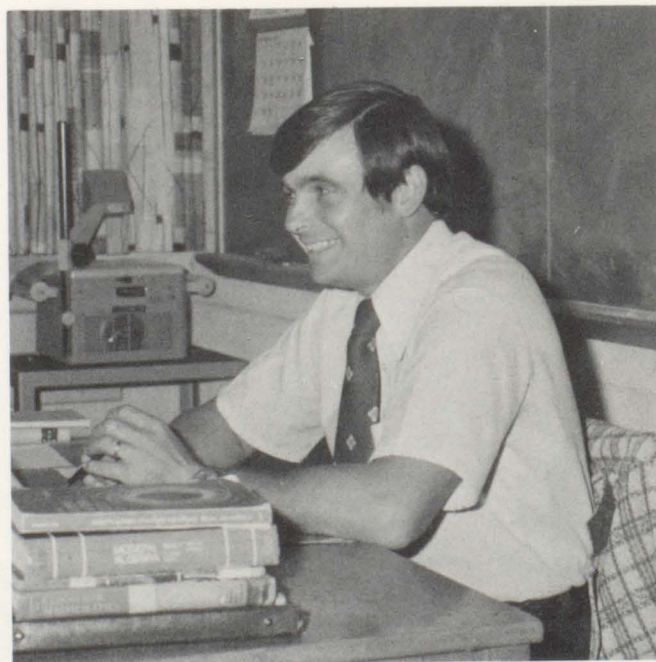

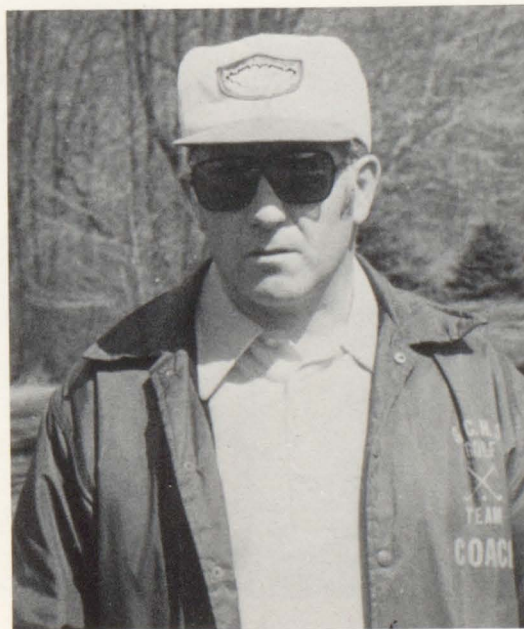

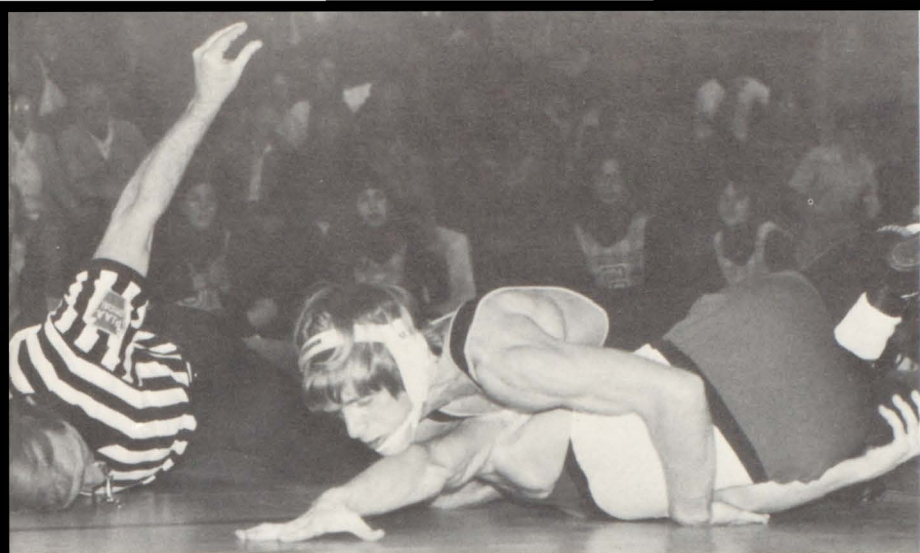

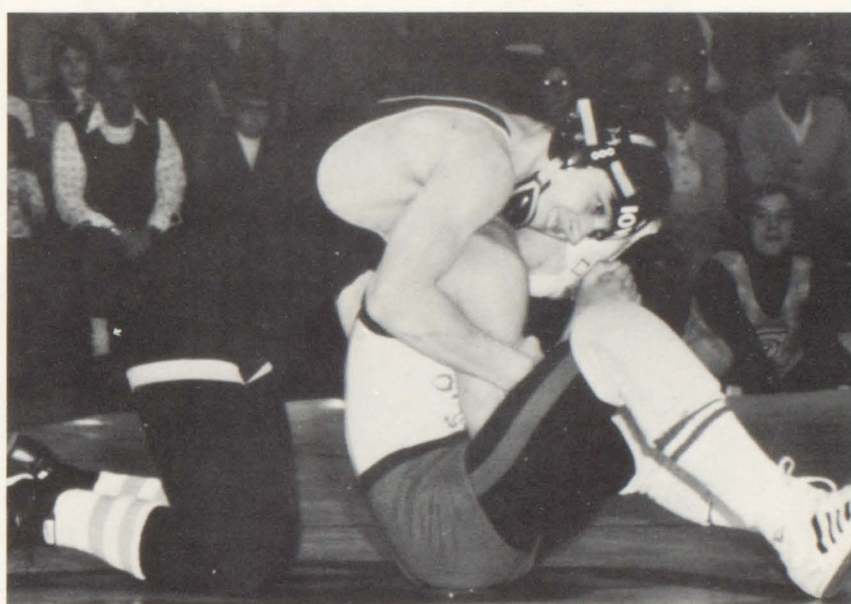

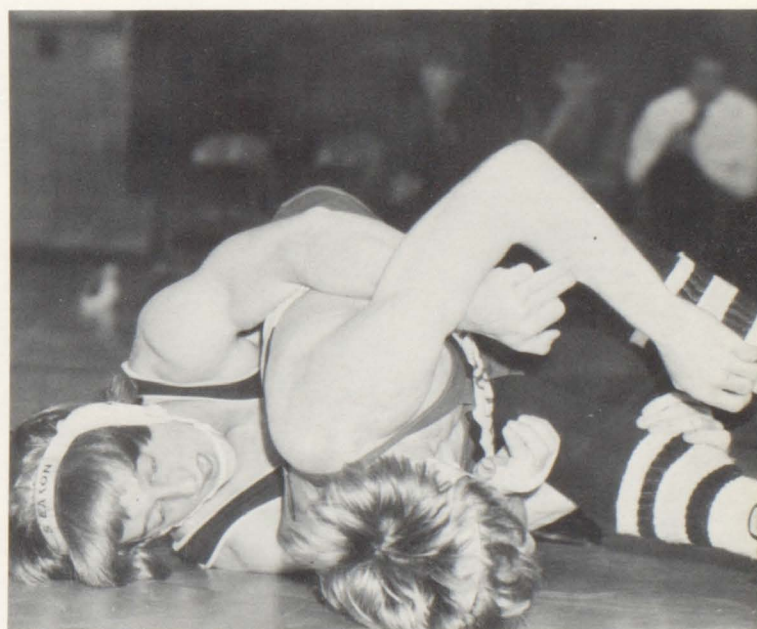

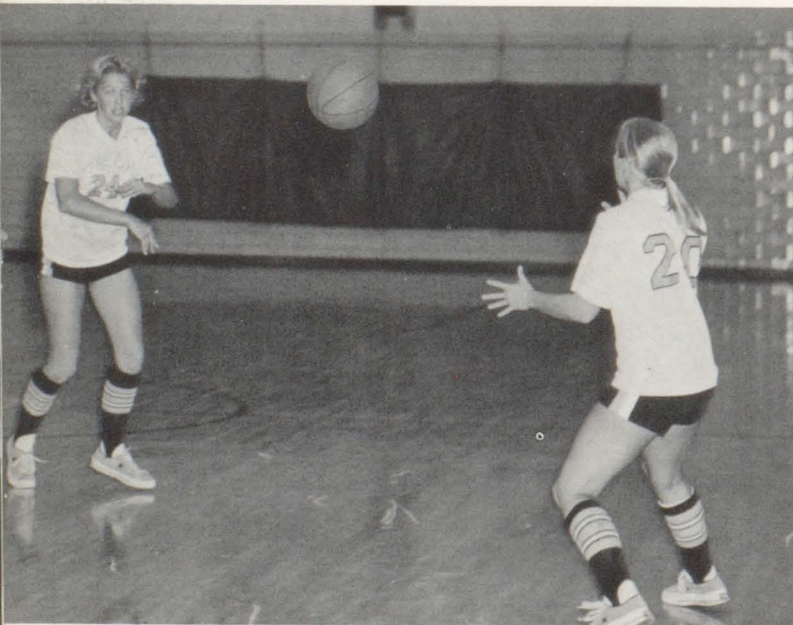

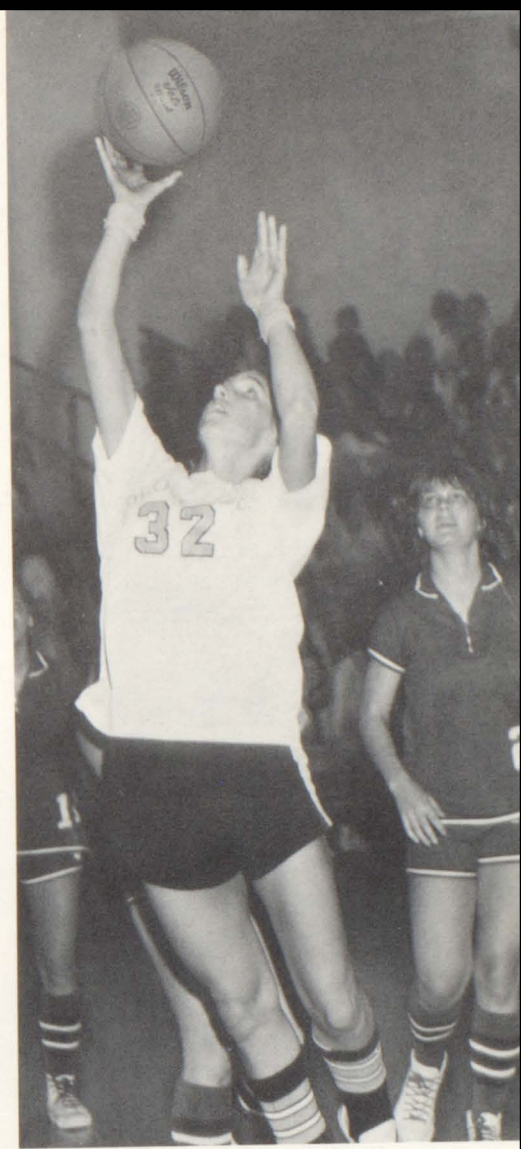

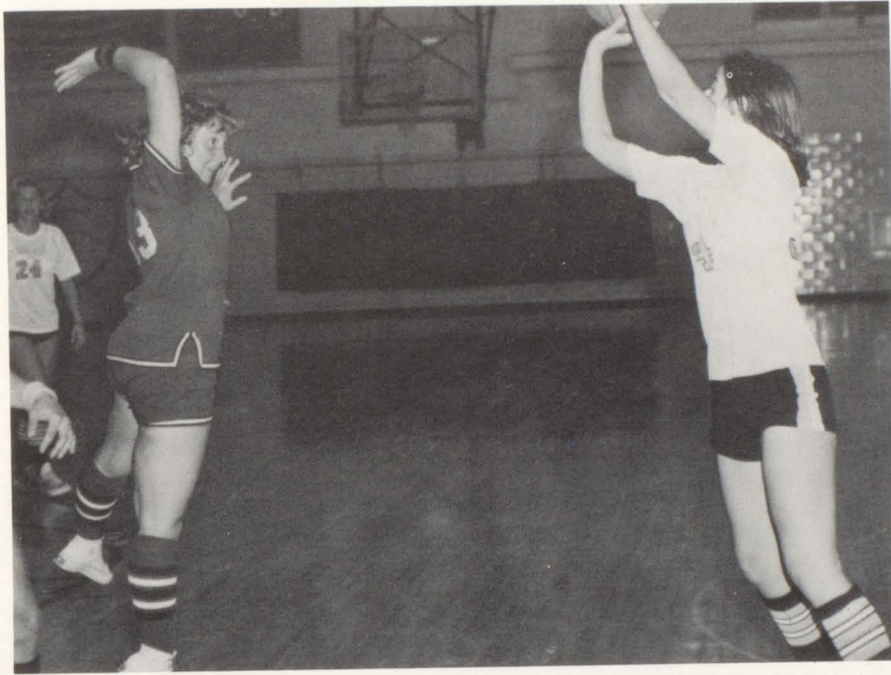

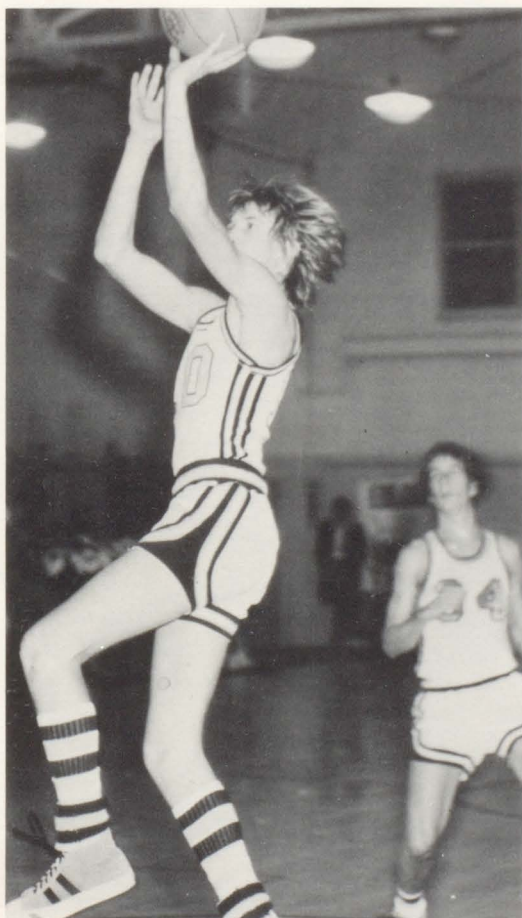

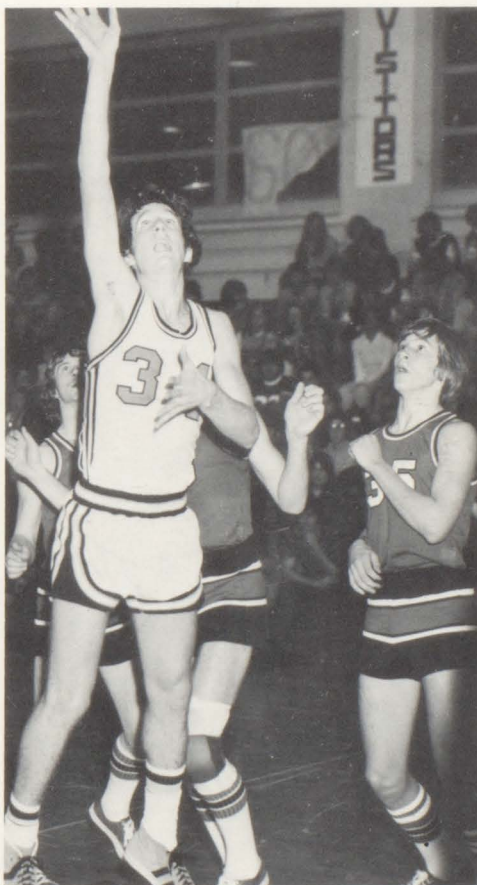
