


MATH CLUB
















FOOTBALL

Coach Don Gill was justifiably disappointed in his second season as head coach of the Grove City Eagles. The Eagle team hit its unavoidable "lean" year with only two returning lettermen. Had not the other area schools boasted a bonus year of lettermen and experience, the record might have been better. Grove City's only win, over Sharpsville, was exuberantly welcomed by the still loyal Eagle fans. Game attendance reached its peak in the final game of the season.

This season did have one bright spot in Bob Irvine's superb running ability. Bob gained a total of 921 yards in 175 carries for a 5.26 yard per carry average. He had his best game against Mercer in which he gained

241 yards in 24 carries. The other Eagle statistics were as follows: 83 first downs, 1612 yards gained, 53 passes attempted, 18 passes completed, 4 passes intercepted by us, 23 fumbles, and 356 penalties.

Grove City's opponents had 100 first downs, 2722 yards gained, 86 passes attempted, 47 passes completed, 5 intercepted passes, 16 fumbles, and 547 penalties.












Bruce Ketler (14) shoots from the key while John McMichael looks on.



Robbie Wood tries another hook shot with Glenn Mathieson ready to assist.




