## FOREWORD

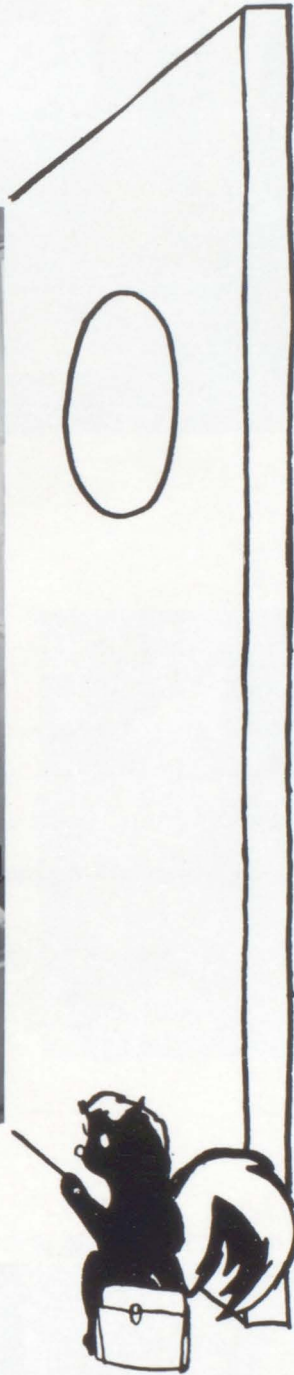
